Dear Parents,

I am sure you are fully aware of the announcement yesterday afternoon from NI Education Minister, Mr Peter Weir, informing us that schools will officially close from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March until further notice. We will keep you updated via 'Windmillips App' and school website, www.windmillips.com

Staff have been working diligently preparing work packs and online activities for your child to last till the end of the summer term. I am sure you can appreciate that this is such a mammoth task.

The learning packs and letters from class teachers containing your child's log in details are to be picked up from the school assembly hall anytime from **12 noon to 3pm on Friday 20**<sup>th</sup> **March.** If you are working or self-isolating, please send a family member or friend to pick up the pack. Please use this opportunity to return any school trophies that your child received at Prizegiving in June 2019.

If your child has left an inhaler or epi-pen in school these may also be collected tomorrow (Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March) from 12noon to 3pm.

All your child's belongings can also be collected at this time.

There will be information with your pack to explain what home learning will look like. The activities will enable your child to keep the momentum of learning going. Activities will involve revision of work undertaken to date, work that is currently being undertaken as well as new learning.

When covering new areas of learning staff will give instructions/advice in the form of notes, examples, video demonstrations as well as recommending links to relevant websites.
